

### **ABOUT THE GAME**

Never a dull moment with Masha and the Bear! Today they are having an exciting competition!

In "Masha and the Bear: Hide-and-Seek" the players will have to search for pairs of cards with matching pictures.

> The fastest and most diligent player wins!

The game rules are designed to be read by adults.

Game rules

There are two types of cards in the game, all of which are double-sided.

YELLOW cards are the Challenge cards. One side features a character, the other side features an item.

GREEN cards (on one side) and BLUE (on the other side) are the Hide-and-Seek cards. Each side of such cards features both a picture of a character and an item.

#### Information for people with CVD!

The Challenge cards (the yellow ones) are labelled with a daisy symbol. The green side of Hide-and-Seek cards is labelled with a butterfly symbol. The blue side of Hide-and-Seek cards is labelled with a spruce tree symbol.



Shuffle the Hide-and-Seek deck

Spread the Hide-and-Seek cards randomly on the table with the blue side up in a way so that both pictures on each card are clearly visible to all players.

Shuffle the Challenge deck and place it at the center of the table any side up: the side that is facing up will be considered the back for this game.

# **GAME FLOW**

The youngest player goes first. They quickly flip the entire Challenge deck and the game begins! All players simultaneously search for the character or item featured on the top Challenge card among the pictures on Hide-and-Seek cards.

To make the game trickier and more fun, the Characters and items are depicted a bit differently on the Challenge cards and the Hide-and-Seek cards. For example, the items are rotated in different ways while the characters can be posed differently or hold something different in their hands (or paws).

Important! The main characters of the Masha and the Bear animated series are depicted in different outfits and looks. When searching among the pictures on Hide-and-Seek cards you have to look for the character wearing the same outfit as they are in the Challenge card. For example, if the yellow card features Masha in a doctor costume or the Bear in a spacesuit, you have to look for those particular looks of the characters on the blue cards.

> CORRECTI MISTAKE!



The first player to find the right Hide-and-Seek card points to it and announces the item or character so that all other players can see it and make sure it's the correct picture. After that the lucky player takes the completed Challenge card (the yellow one).

The game continues immediately! The players get to look at the next Challenge card in the deck and begin searching among the Hide-and-Seek cards. The game continues like this until the Challenge deck runs out.



At the end of the game, the player that has collected the most Challenge cards wins.

If several players have collected the same number of cards, they both win. Yay!

### SIMPLIFIED GAME FOR YOUNGER PLAYERS

When playing with preschool age children you can use the green side of Hide-and-Seek cards instead of the blue side. There are two pictures on the green side as well (a character and an item) but they are depicted exactly as they are on the yellow Challenge cards. Whenever the young Masha and the Bear fans get familiar with this version of the game, make sure to try playing using the blue side of Hide-and-Seek cards!

# FAQ:

What if a player announced a character but did not point to a card?

This way of finding a card does not count.

#### What if several players found the right card at the same time?

If the players can't decide who was first, the card is out of the game.

### Can you only use a part of the Challenge deck to play?

You can adjust the size of the Challenge deck to your liking to make the game shorter or longer. Remember, you still have to use all of the Hide-and-Seek cards!

### Can you stop the game before the Challenge deck runs out?

If the players wish to, they can stop the game at any time and continue to scoring their points.



If you prefer to search for hidden Masha and the Bear characters instead of items, make sure all Challenge cards in the deck are facing down and shuffle the deck. Now when you play, every Challenge card will have a picture of one of your favorite characters on it!
